Virtual Train-the-Trainer Course Announcement

The National TIM Responder Training Program was developed by responders for responders, and was designed to promote consistent training of all responders to achieve the TIM National Unified Goal (NUG), which is a commitment to:

- The Safety of Responders and All Road Users
- Safe, Quick Clearance
- Communication, Coordination, and Cooperation

The Train-the-Trainer (TtT) course is intended to provide participants (i.e., trainers) with the knowledge and materials necessary for them to conduct TIM Responder Training sessions for responders in their area or state.

Participant expectations:

- **Prior instructional and TIM experience**
- **Commitment to providing training to other TIM responders in your area**
- **Commitment to submitting your training records**

The target audience for this course is all TIM disciplines, including: Communications, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), Fire/Rescue, Law Enforcement, Towing and Recovery, and Transportation/Public Works.

The Federal Highway Administration is offering four virtual TtT sessions across a range of days, times, and time zones. All options are open to individuals from all 50 States, D.C., and Puerto Rico, but each session will be limited to 40 participants.

Option 33: Tuesday, December 8, 2026

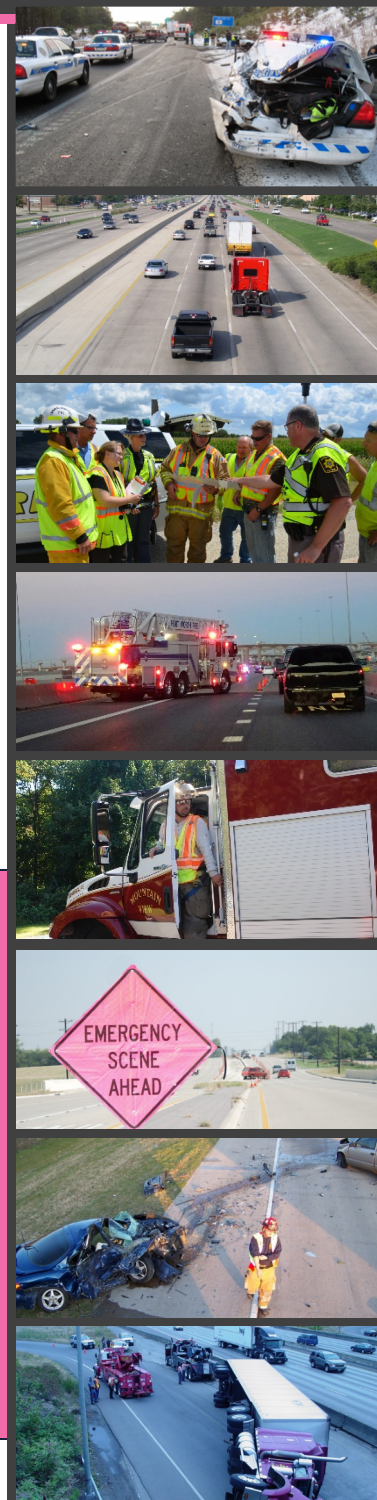
